HISTORY OF THE CLOTHESLINE ART SHOW

The first of the shows was held in 1952 as a result of a conversation over coffee between Clarence W. Lininger, President of the Board of Directors of the Kalamazoo Institute of Arts and Phil Wight, art critic for the Kalamazoo Gazette. The show was an immediate success. Through the years it has continued to grow in size and to attract attention from both artists and the public in an ever increasing radius. Artists have come from as far away as Denver, Colorado and eastern seaboard to participate in the Show.

It offers the public an opportunity to see a wide variety of work in many media and to purchase original works by artists and craftsmen. Sales at the Show are always brisk and the afternoon is marked by the sight of many people struggling to their cars laden with paintings, ceramics, sculpture and numerous other works.

The show has been the subject of articles in many newspapers and other medium. It was selected by the Ford Times as one of the three such shows throughout the nation which were covered in an issue of that magazine dealing with outdoor art shows.

This years proves to surpass all others with more exhibitors and the addition of the Children's Fair area.

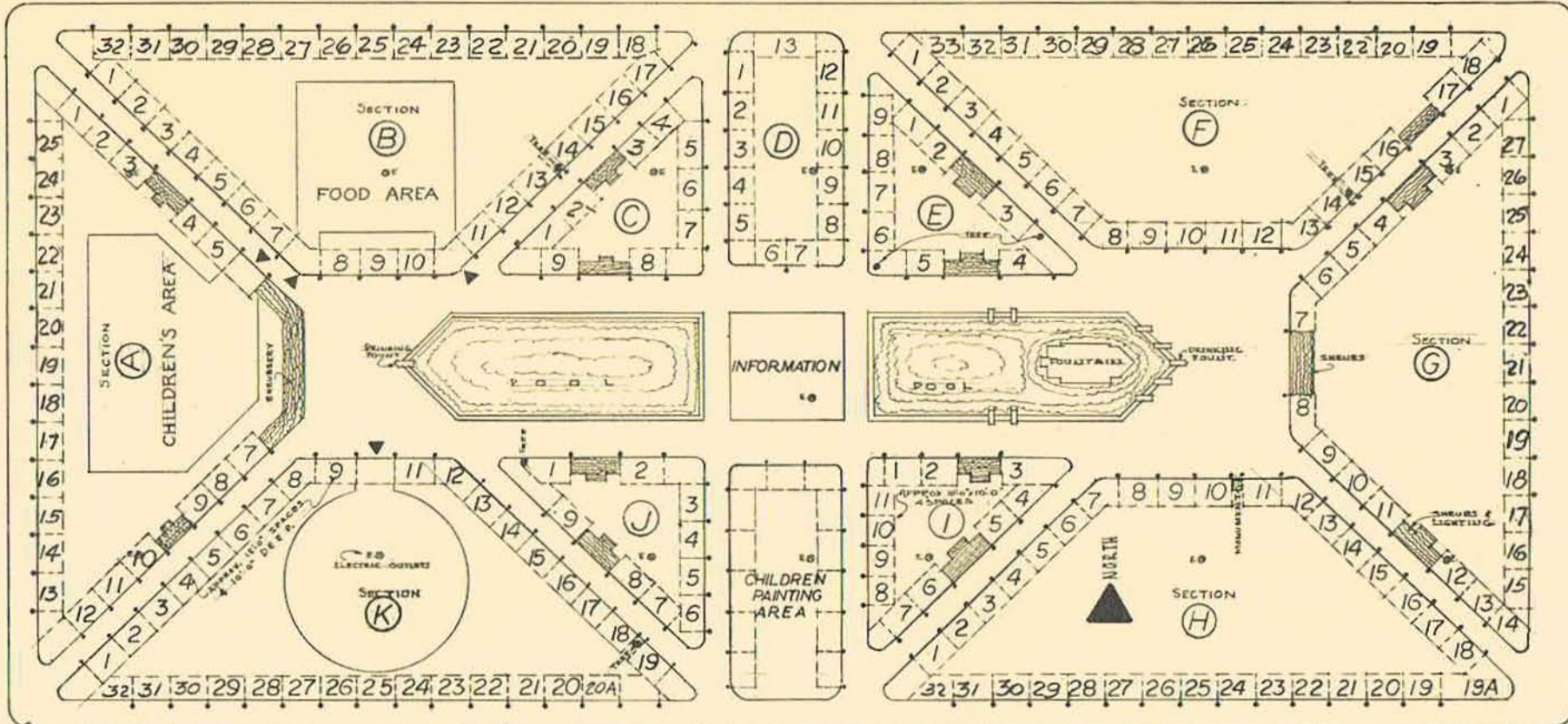
